May you all have a great weekend and enjoy the sunshine.

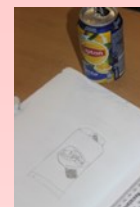
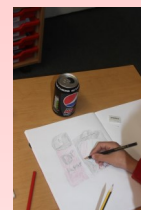

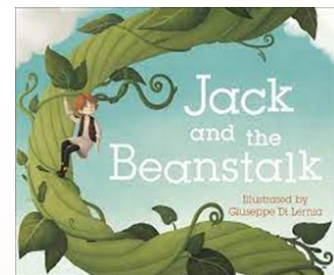
## Creativity
